2. Budget, Amy Dangel

The PTO's fund is dwindling and we need to replenish it. The classroom set-up budget has gone up from last year due to the thirteen additional staff this year. Specials Supplies costs went up from last year. Teachers must try to get grants to cover supplies. We added \$5k to their budget to help cover costs. Another hit to the budget are the PTO sponsors field trips, which are a huge expenditure. Marissa makes motion to approve budget. Cindy seconds the motion. Budget approved.

3. Volunteering

Process of retrieving a badge is explained. As long as there is a teacher present you can use the lobby guard sticker machine.

If you want to go on a field trip, you must get the full badge from security. Badges last five years.

We have fundraising ideas however we need volunteers to implement them. Any amount of volunteering helps! If you are able and willing to volunteer we welcome that. It will also help you become more familiar with the school.

4. Fundraising

The school has experiences 25% increase in enrollment over last year. With the growth of student volume, our expenses go up. That means fundraising is very important this year.

6. Facilities

There is a tree near the playground with a lot of dead branches on it that is a concern. The district is aware of this but they haven't done anything yet. It is a safety concern. 7. Vice Principal

We have a new Vice Principal this year, Ms. Sunderman.

8. Ms. Amat

Thank you for your support! We just hired 13 excellent new staff members. Thank you PTO for supporting our yearly staff retreat.

Parent teacher conferences and Open House is coming up. It is a district requirement to have Open House even though we have several other similar events such as the Ice Cream Social.

Math Workshop is coming up for parents on Wednesday.
