1. Principal's Report - Jill Sunderman

- All staffing requests were approved by district. We need to figure out what space new staff can use and then start candidate searches.

 - Room basket group is meeting tonight and more details will be shared soon.
 - Spring Celebration has room for more volunteers.
- Athletic Director Report – Mike Brugh
 - Basketball season is wrapping up.
 - Spring registration has opened and closed for most sports, Baseball closes tomorrow. Running club signups will come later.
 - Volleyball starts next week – we have 3 teams!
 - Finances are trending well and Boosters will split bank accounts from PTO soon.
