### 7:10 Principal's Report – Jill Sunderman

- We're in a good position as far as keeping the school open. We've had less than 10 staff members out.
- Goal of the school and entire staff to stay in-person
- We're in the heart of MAP and iReady testing and parents will get reports in February during conferences
- We should be breaking ground in 2022 for the school expansion
- District has projected 565 kids and we're currently at 551; we continue to gain enrollment
- If someone tests positive, you can return on the 6<sup>th</sup> day as long as you have no symptoms. If you have symptoms you have to do the rest of the 10 day quarantine
- Close contacts can stay in school if they show no symptoms, but if they have symptoms they have to do the structure for quarantine described above about 5 and 10 days.
