- Financial Update – Page Lee - Around \$1200 in sponsorships today not reflected on spreadsheet yet. In addition ~\$18,000 in sponsorships so far. Approx \$1000 in Kroger card rewards to come. Shopping card increased \$500 since last month. We have done field trips for K-2, clocks for 2nd, storage bins for teachers, supplies for STEAM and French elective, Lunch on conference day, treats for HP Heroes... we also used most of

our money left at JB for a set of books for 5th grade. Field trip funds still has some remaining - saving for some to come.

CRC meeting 3/1 to hopefully hire our Resource Coordinator. LSDMC will hold interviews with candidates that CRC provides - more info next month.

7:10 Principal's Report – Jill Sunderman - Summer Scholars 190 kids signed up (more than last year) and most are doing full day (academic morning, enrichment afternoon). 99% of staff will be HPS (additional staff that will sub is Mr. Tate's wife).
